GREYWACKE BOTRYTIS PINOT GRIS 2013

'Gorgeously luscious aroma of apricots and dried pears. Viscously mouth-filling and with terrific intensity of dried pear and fresh apricot, the aroma matched perfectly on the palate. It is extremely sweet but has perfectly balanced acidity. Attention-grabbingly delicious. Long and decadent. The best vintage of this wine I have tasted. And still so youthful and a long way ahead.'

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GREYWACKE BOTRYTIS PINOT GRIS 2011

'Very attractive clotted cream and lime curd on the nose, gently spicy and really pristine. The palate has a very smooth spicy citrus thread, with saffron, lime curd and lemon; bright and pure, balanced, powerful, terrific sticky wine. Drink now and for another 5+ years.'
